

Rules and Regulations

1. Entries are to be presented in a clear container unless otherwise specified
2. A 'bowl' is a container, the height of which is less than the diameter of its circular opening
3. A 'vase' is a container, the height of which is greater than the diameter of its circular opening
4. A 'trough' is a container which is longer than its height
5. For Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4, flowers (whether cultivated or native varieties) must be grown by the exhibitor
6. Sections 5 and 7 are judged on artistic ability. Flowers (cut) or foliage used may have been purchased or grown by the exhibitor
7. A 'posy' (wired or stemmed) is composed of small flowers, is slightly domed & backed with paper, leaves or fabric
8. Each exhibitor's items are to be listed on one form. Junior entries on one form and age included
9. All decisions of the judge are final

Entry forms and entry fees are due by 3pm on Friday 14th September

Delivery of exhibits: Saturday 15th September between 8am and 10am

Judging: Saturday 15th September between 10am and 1pm

Collection of exhibits: Sunday 16th September between 3pm and 4pm

SECTION 1 - 3 to 6 stems in a clear container

- 1.1 Stock (with or without laterals)
- 1.2 Sweet peas
- 1.3 Pansies
- 1.4 Freesias - (a) White or Cream (b) Coloured
- 1.5 Sturt's Desert Pea
- 1.6 Carnations
- 1.7 Ranunculi
- 1.8 Geraniums / Pelargoniums
- 1.9 Any other variety

SECTION 2 - Roses in a clear container

- 2.1 1 Rose - any colour
- 2.2 3 Red Roses
- 2.3 3 Pink Roses
- 2.4 3 White Roses
- 2.5 3 Yellow Roses
- 2.6 3 Roses of any other colour
- 2.7 1 cut floribunda
- 2.8 1 cut miniature
- 2.9 Banksia rose - single stem

SECTION 3 - Collection in a clear container

- 3.1 Best collection of mixed bulbs or rhizomes (1 stem of each)
- 3.2 Best collection of flowers (1 stem of each)
- 3.3 Best collection of Australian native flowers (1 stem of each)

SECTION 4 - Single exhibit other than roses

- 4.1 Best single bloom: no bud or laterals permitted
- 4.2 Best single stem

SECTION 5 - Floral Art

- 5.1 Vase of flowers - judged for arrangement
- 5.2 Bowl of flowers - judged for arrangement
- 5.3 Trough of flowers - judged for arrangement
- 5.4 Low centre piece for dinner table - candles may be used
- 5.5 Composition using one flower - any foliage
- 5.6 Arrangement in an unusual container
- 5.7 Arrangement of Australian native flowers and foliage
- 5.8 Arrangement of flowers and fruit
- 5.9 Arrangement of dried or preserved materials
- 5.10 Posy, up to 15 cm (6") overall

SECTION 6 - Pot Plants

- 6.1 Foliage plant
- 6.2 Single plant in flower
- 6.3 Annual/s in flower
- 6.4 Hanging Basket
- 6.5 Fern
- 6.6 Pot of mixed planting - 2 or more
- 6.7 Potted succulent
- 6.8 Potted succulent - 2 or more
- 6.9 Potted cactus
- 6.10 Potted cacti - 2 or more
- 6.11 Collection of herbs in a container
- 6.12 Bonsai

SECTION 7 - Junior: 16 years and under

Junior exhibitors will be judged in age groups;
8 years and under / 9 to 12 years / 13 to 16 years

- 7.1 Arrangement of Australian native flowers
- 7.2 Miniature garden - arranged
- 7.3 Vase of flowers - judged for arrangement
- 7.4 Arrangement in an unusual container
- 7.5 Posy up to 15 cm overall
- 7.6 Low centrepiece for dinner table - no candles
- 7.7 Floral saucer - outer edge to be covered
- 7.8 Decorated saucer - accessories may be added
- 7.9 Dried arrangement
- 7.10 Fruit, vegetable or paddy melon animal
